



Comet Pan-STARRS is shown above the western horizon at 6:30 pm (EST) in Tupper Lake on March 7 and four minutes earlier each night through March 19, when it will be at 6:42 pm (EDT). The comet is predicted to be as bright as Hamal in Aries. On March 13 - 16, the crescent moon will also be in the western sky. After this, the moon may make the sky too bright for the comet to be easily found. Made using Starry Night software.
