*we'll look for anything...*while we cannot guarantee absolutely any request we will do everything we can to get you the material you need

*it's free...*for the SLU Community there is no cost associated with interlibrary loan

*electronic delivery is a default option...*you can set up electronic delivery as a preference for the articles you receive, and, in most cases, we can get you electronic copy

*issn makes the world go around...*providing the ISSN number in a request can significantly increase the speed of the delivery of the article. ILL requests from the Find@SLU page are filled out automatically with ISSN numbers
