I don't feel like I can ask questions entirely in just a single piazza post or email. I understand this is a summer course and a lot of information needs to be covered in a short period of time, but if the coding examples were a little bit slowed down when done I would have been able to get them to work during class. I always found myself playing catch up when the coding examples were done in class and towards the second half of the course I began to rely on the example codes to be posted rather than getting them right in class.
